Extracts from the Gazette of India, June 5th to 12th, 1869.

LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT.

The following Act of the Governor General of India in Council received the assent of His Excellency the Governor General on the 4th day of June 1869, and is hereby promulgated for general information;—

ACT No. XV or 1869.

An Acr to provide, facilities for obtaining the evidence and appearance of prisoners and for service of process upon them.

Preamble.

Whereas it is expedient to provide facilities for obtaining the evidence and appearance in Court of prisoners and for service of process upon them; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

I.—Preliminary.

Short title.

- 1. This Act may be called "The Prisoners' Testimony Act, 1869."
- 2. For the purposes of this Act, the Courts of Small Causes established within the local limits of the ordinary original civil jurisdiction of the High Courts of Judicature at Fort William, Madras and Bombay and the Courts of persons exercising the powers of a Magistrates.

II .- Bringing up Prisoners.

3. Any criminal Court not inferior to the Court of a Subordinate Magistrate of the first Class may in its discretion, if it appear that the testimony of any person confined in any jail Criminal Courts may situate within the local imits of its appellate jurisdiction, if the criminal court be make orders under Act.

Aligh Court, or, if it be not a High Court, then within the local limits of the appellate jurisdiction of the High Court, to which it is subordinate, is material in any matter depending in such criminal court, or if a charge of an offence against such person is made or pending, make an order in the form in schedule A or schedule B (as the case may be) to this Act anuexel, directed to the officer in charge of the said jail.
